

GCSE

Students are able to study Art and Design at GCSE level over 3 years. All Students are encouraged to develop individual pathways in areas of personal interest. The teacher comes alongside students to suggest areas where the student might develop a skill or research a particular artist or art movement which ties in with the students' interests. The work is assessed using 4 categories; Research, Experimentation, Planning and Outcome.

Outcomes are chosen by students to showcase the ways they prefer to work and could be wall hanging, ceramic piece or large scale painting.

75% of the final mark is given from coursework and in the final year of study the students will develop a body of work from a title in the exam paper which culminates in a 10/15 hour examination.
